RESOLUTION NO. 273-83-A

WHEREAS, The Wisconsin Public Service Corporation of Green Bay, Wisconsin, has made application to erect and maintain an electric distribution line not to exceed 14.4 KV over Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Tribal Lands described as: Part of Government Lot 20, Northwest one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 36, Township 24 North, Range 19 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin; and,

WHEREAS, The installation of this electric service line is expected to benefit the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

By this Council in Special Session assembled, that the Superintendent of the Great Lakes Agency, Ashland, Wisconsin, is hereby authorized to approve a service line agreement covering the above-described electric distribution line without damages, in accordance with Departmental Regulation 25 C.F.R. 161; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

That the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin be authorized to execute the agreement in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
