the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS

the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians

WHEREAS

the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS

the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: GREG S. & ANNETTE M. GRAY, 187 WESTFIELD ROAD, TAX PARCEL #HB-1371-7

WHEREAS

the parcel is described as follows:

THAT PART OF INDIAN CLAIM 172, SECTION THIRTY-FOUR (34), TOWNSHIP TWENTY-FOUR (24) NORTH, RANGE NINETEEN (19) EAST OF THE FOURTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN THE TOWN OF HOBART, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
