WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Indians is concerned with its sovereign right to tax or not to tax tribal members working and living on trust Land, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Indians is concerned with its sovereign right to tax tribal and individual

Indian owned businesses doing businesses on trust Land, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Indians feels that this power to tax is exclusive with each tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Indians feels that State taxation affects its exclusive power to tax and affects individual tribal member's rights to be free of state's power to collect State Income tax,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Indians through its duly elected Tribal Council goes on record in support of challenging the power of the State of Wisconsin to tax Indian employees, Indian owned businesses, and Indian Tribes,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that through its duly elected tribal council authorizes the Native American Rights Fund, Boulder, Colorado; Wisconsin Judicare, Wausau, Wisconsin; Wisconsin Indian Legal Services, Madison, Wisconsin and Wisconsin Indian Development Corporation's legal counsel to serve as its legal counsel in any legal proceeding arising out of the taxation issue, provided, that the cost for such legal services is not charged to the Oneida Tribe of Wisconsin Indians.
