RESOLUTION NO. 3-17-80B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is eligible to apply for contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to plan, conduct, and administer all parts of Bureau authorized programs, under authority of Public Law 93-638 and,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Governing body has determined that it wished to exercise the contracting option that shall review the contract and any amendments thereto before the execution and,

WHEREAS, the scope of the contract is to plan, conduct and administer the Tribal home vegetable garden project and,


WHEREAS, the authorities granted herein shall be effective until such time as the Tribal Governing body takes further action by resolution and,

WHEREAS, the proposed date for start of the contract is April 1, 1980 and shall be effective through September 30, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.
