BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS MASTER CONTRACT RESOLUTION NO: 3-23-83-A

Whereas, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is responsible for providing and/or facilitating educational opportunities for it's tribal members, and,

Whereas, It is the intent of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin to optimally administer and manage all programs directly effecting it's membership, and,

Whereas, Public Law 93-638 stipulates that Indian Tribes "are entitled to contract with the Bureau to plan, conduct, and administer all or parts of any program which the Bureau is authorized to administer..." and,

Whereas, The Self-Determination policy becomes manifest with self-direction and implementation,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin request to contract and administer the following Bureau of Indian Affairs contract programs for fiscal year 1984 utilizing the Master Contract concept:

Be It Further Resolved, that FY'84 contract negotiations, amendments and/or modifications be initiated through the Oneida Education Director and Oneida Tribal Administrator who will seek final approval of the Oneida Business Committee.

Be It Further Resolved, that allocations pertaining to these contracts be made in accordance with the cash advance/cost reimbursable method of contracting. Amounts to be advanced by the Bureau should be consistant with attached cash flow analysis pertaining to each program within the body of each contract. The initial advance is to be made available to Oneida no later than October 1, 1983. The proposed term of this contract is established as three years beginning with fiscal year 1984, October 1, 1983 through September 30, 1984 with provisions for renewal of the Oneida Master Contract for FY'85 and FY'86.
