Tribal Sovereignty Ordinance

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a Federally recognized Tribe organized under the Indian Reorganization Act.

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe and the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is striving to develop an efficient Tribal operation.

WHEREAS, when the Tribal operation expands it becomes necessary to develop additional guidelines and ordinances to achieve the basic objectives of an efficient Tribal operation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee does hereby promulgate and enact the following ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE

Stabilizing Tribal Sovereignty

- A. Since all Tribal Programs are an arm of Tribal Government, any employee or official of any such Tribal Program who shall file any action, suit or other legal process against the Tribe in any way placing Tribal sovereignty and immunity from suit in jeopardy shall be immediately terminated from employment with said program.
- B. Any employee of any Tribal Program engaging in any conduct detrimental or undermining to such programs or Tribal Government shall be cause for immediate dismissal by action of the Tribal Business Committee.
