WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has various grants from the U.S. Department of Health Education and Welfare and that the HEW region V office 300 South Wacker Drive, Chicago, Illinois 60605 is the agency that administrates a majority of HEW grants,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has not negotiated an indirect cost rate with the HEW Region V office,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Indian Tribe is eligible to charge indirect ^{costs} for various HEW grants,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee approves negotiating indirect cost rate as outlined in DHEW Publication No. (05) 72-28; and that Robert L. Christjohn, Oneida Tribal Administrator, is authorized to negotiate indirect costs with HEW Region V office.
