## RESOLUTION 5-21-84-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has placed a high priority on economic development, job training, and job placements, and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has initiated extensive efforts to carry out job training and general employment assistance for an extended period of time, and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians has sought out and been active in developing a variety of educational, economic and employment programs with other Tribes in the State for an extended period of time, and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians has become a member of the Wisconsin Southern Tribes Consortium that consists of Winnebago, Menominee, Stockbridge-Munsee, and Oneida, and,

WHEREAS, the Consortium of Southern Tribes of Wisconsin have developed a grant to provide technical assistance which maybe funded by the Wisconsin Governors Employment and Training Office.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin continue to support and develop employment assistance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin request the Wisconsin Governors Employment and Training Office to provide favorable review and eventual funding approval for the technical assistance grant.
