## RESOLUTION # 05-27-98-C

### Administration for Children One-Time Grant Application

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Three Sisters Head Start is in need of a new facility to house the Head Start program, and
- WHEREAS, One-Time funding is available through the Federal Head Start for large projects, and
- HEREAS Oneida Economic Development has completed a business plan outlining the development of the new Three Sisters Head Start building including construction, budget and programmatic aspects.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin submits a grant application to the Administration for Children, Youth and Families for a One-Time grant from the Head Start Bureau.
