WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is organized in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984), and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee met in Special Session on the 6th day of June, 1976, and


WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee requests that Fiscal Year 1977 Indian Action Team contracting services remain with the Indian Technical Assistance Center, Denver, Colorado,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests to waive BIA Agency, and/or Area Indian Action Team contractual services under PL 93-638, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee requests Indian Action Team contractual services be provided via the Indian Technical Assistance Center, BIA, Denver, Colorado.
