RESOLUTION # 6-28-95-6

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Christine J. Stevens, a tribal member holder of lease no RL-1162(78) described as follows:

A parcel of land within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Secation 13, Township 23 North, Range 18 East, 4th P.M., Outagamie County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the NE corner of said SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13; thence South along the East section line, 165.0 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning, which is located on the South line of Lot 13, thence West along said South line, 660.0 feet; thence North at a right angle, 132.0 feet; thence East parallel with said South line, 660.0 feet; thence South along the East section line, 132.0 feet to the Point of Beginning, containg 2.00 acres, more or les, and subject to all valid, existing rights-of-way of record.

DELETE: Christine J. Stevens, a tribal member.


INSERT: Christine J. Stevens and Aleanora K. Stevens (mother and daughter), both tribal members.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee in Regular Session assembled, hereby approves the *MODIFICATION of lease no. RL-1162(78)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease *MODIFICATION documents for and in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
