RESOLUTION NO. 1

WHEREAS, the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, Ashland, Wisconsin, has received an application from James H. Schanandore, owner of a 1/15 undivided interest in the Oneida allotment of Daniel S. Skenandoah, Oneida Allottee No. 1410, indicating his desire to effect an exchange of his 1/15 undivided interest for a parcel of tribal land held in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the proposal of James H. Schanandore would cause him to convey, in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, a 1/15 undivided interest in the aforementioned allotment in exchange for Lot "X", Section 34, Township 24 North, Range 18 East, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin holds a 1/2 undivided interest in and to this same allotment and it is their desire to obtain as much of the interests of the allotment as possible, and

WHEREAS, by a majority vote and consent of the members of the General Council, it was concluded and determined to be in the best interests of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin to accept the proposal of James H. Schanandore and convey said Lot "X" in exchange for his 1/15 undivided interest, be it

RESOLVED, by this Council in regular session assembled that we hereby recommend to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to approve the exchange as proposed.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, hereby certify that the General Council is composed of 55 members of whom 50 constituting a quorum were present at a meeting thereof, duly and regularly called, noticed, convened and held on this 3 day of July, 1961, and that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at said meeting by an affirmative vote of 39 members and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
