RESOLUTION OF THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN, INC., OF ONEIDA, BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN, APPROVING THE AWARDING OF THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO THE LOW BIDDERS FOR THE ONEIDA NATION MEMORIAL COMMUNITY BUILDING, PROJECT NUMBER WIS-N-3/06-2-00979

WHEREAS, on June 29, 1972, bids were received and opened by the Oneida tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc., of Oneida, Brown County, Wisconsin, for Project Number Wisconsin-N-3/06-2-00979.

WHEREAS, the bids received were good and valid, and

WHEREAS, the budget is adequate to permit award of Contract, and;

WHEREAS, there has been no objection or disapproval of this project from the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc.. of Oneida, Brown County, Wisconsin or by referendum from voters of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. and
