RESOLUTION NO. 7-18-77-D

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisc. has contracted for the delivery of Health Care Services from IHS for the past several years, and

WHEREAS, a volunteer health clinic has been in operation on the Oneida Reservation since Sept. 1973, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has a developmental IHS contract for the last 3 years and have demonstrated and proved their capability to deliver limited health care, and


WHEREAS, there is now a health clinic under construction scheduled for completion in Dec. 1977, and

WHEREAS, Congress has appropriated the sum of \$623,000 for the operation and equipment, and staff for the clinic and other health care contract services,

NOW THEREFORE BE RESOLVED THAT the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisc., desire under PL-638 to contract for the Congressional appropriation from Indian Health Services to operate the Health Clinic.
