RESOLUTION # 8-15-84-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated its governing powers to the Oneida Business Committee subject to the Oneida Business Committee subject to the review of the Oneida General tribal Council, and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is desirous of protecting its natural resources on the Oneida Indian Reservation, including all game and fish, and,

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has adopted regulations for the protection of deer and fish on the Oneida Indian Reservation for the purpose of enforcement of tribal laws, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe will issue permits and all licenses to tribal members for the purpose of enforcing the Oneida Tribe's conservation laws, and,

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe is informed by Mr. Charles McCuddy, Rights Protection Specialist, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Great Lakes Agency, that \$1,500 is available for the purpose of issuing permits and licenses on the reservation, and,


WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has determined that his is an appropriate purpose to which enforcement funds may be applied.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe will apply to the Rights Protection Office for \$1,500 in the implementation of its rights protection for the purpose of issuing Oneida tribal permits and licenses to its members that hunt or fish on the Oneida Indian Reservation.
