Resolution for Tribal Membership in the
NATIONAL CONGRESS OF AMERICAN INDIANS

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wis. Tribe wishes to become a Member Tribe of the National Congress of American Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe meets all requirements for Tribal Membership pursuant to the Constitution and By-Laws of NCAI; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee of the Oneida of Wis. (Governing Body) Tribe hereby authorizes the Chairman (Principal officer) of the Tribe to secure Tribal Membership in NCAI for the Tribe; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Tribal Funds in the amount of \$ 192.00 based on the Tribal Membership Dues Schedule of the NCAI By-Laws (Article III, Section 1, b) are authorized to be paid for such Tribal Membership; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that based on membership of 6,653, as verified by the records of Bureau of Indian Affairs (number) (Source of Information) Tribe shall have 170 votes according to the NCAI Constitution (Article IV, Section 3); and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that pursuant to Article V, Sec. 2 of the NCAI Constitution, the Tribe designates Purcell Powless (Name of official delegate) who is an Individual Member of NCAI in good standing, to be its official delegate to NCAI, and designates the following named persons, also Individual Members of NCAI in good standing, to be alternate Delegates: Norbert S. Hill
