RESOLUTION 9-19-80A

WHEREAS, Members of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin are exempt from state sales tax in accordance with Supreme Court Decision Bryan V. Itasca and the State Agreement of 1976 with Wisconsin Indian Nations, and,

WHEREAS, many vendors in Green Bay and other peripheral municipalities often refuse to honor said agreement, even though Tribal enrollment certification and a Tribal source letter is provided,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Law Office meet with the Wisconsin Attorney General and/or the Chief of Compliance, Department of Revenue as expeditiously as possible to:

1. Review, update and negotiate the agreement, if necessary.
2. Provide direction for implementation in the offices.
3. Provide direction for implementation in Reservation areas.
 - a. Develop information for Tribal members on their sales tax status and encourage utilization.
 - b. Develop information for distribution by Tribes to all vendors.
