RESOLUTION # 9-21-94 Z

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Deborah Heckel, a tribal member, residing at W1389 Culbertson Road, Seymour, WI 54165, has submitted an application for a short-term lease for agricultural purposes; and

WHEREAS, the tribal land selection is described as follows:

The N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, and the W 1/2 of Lots A & 10, and the E 1/2 of Lot A, including that portion of the E 1/2 of Lots A & 10, set off for agricultural purposes, and as shown on the attached map with the following EXCEPTION:

Commencing at the NW corner of NW 1/4 SE 1/4; thence South, a distance of 220.0 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence East, 396.00 feet; thence South, a distance of 220.0 feet; thence West, 396.00 feet; thence North, 220 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning, containing 2.0 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

All located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 12, Township 23 North, Range 18 East, 4th P.M., Outagamie County, Wisconsin, containing 22 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, the lease will be for a term of 5 years, with an annual rent of \$88 due on the anniversary of date of approval.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in Regular session assembled, that the lease is hereby approved and requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, to prepare and approve the lease in accordance with applicable regulations; and
