

RESOLUTION NO. 72-10-2

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has received notice from the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council that the termination date of the current Federal Emergency Employment Act contract is November 14, 1972, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin are in need of employment for members of the Tribe, who are unemployed and under employed, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin desire the following types of positions under the Emergency Employment Act and in the order of priority as listed,

1. Director - Manager of Indian activities of the Oneida Indian Center - \$8,320.00 annually
2. Head Carpenter - Home Repair Program - \$8,320.00 annually
3. Housing Authority Clerk - \$4,992.00 annually
4. Two Carpenter Helpers - \$4,972.00 each, annually
5. Oneida C.A.P. Secretary-Receptionist - \$4,200.00 annually
6. Custodian - Oneida Indian Center - \$4,972.00 annually
7. Two Maintenance Men - Housing Project Sites 1 and 2 - \$4,972.00 each, annually.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this committee in regular session assembled, hereby requests the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council to fund the above mentioned positions, under a New Emergency Employment Act contract.
