RESOLUTION NO. 10-23-80 A

WHEREAS, The Business Committee of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, has resolved to terminate its contractual relationship with Marvin S. Chapman, by formal resolution not to seek renewal or extension of said contract, and has so informed Mr. Chapman and appropriate officials of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has designated Francis R. Skenandore to be its attorney of record in all pending land claims litigations, including Docket 301, and

WHEREAS, Francis R. Skenandore and Gerald L. Hill, Oneida Tribal Attorneys, are qualified and have petitioned the U.S. Court of Claims for admission to practice, and

WHEREAS, The Rules of the U.S. Court of Claims requires affirmation of the clients' decision to change attorneys of record by motion for leave of the Court, Rule 203 (c),

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin directs Francis R. Skenandore, Esq., to file appropriate papers with the U.S. Court of Claims for leave to change counsel, thereby formally removing Marvin S. Chapman as the attorney of record in these proceedings, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Francis R. Skenandore, is directed to draft and present to the Oneida Business Committee a contract relative to representation of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in the proceedings known as Docket 301, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Francis R. Skenandore, is directed to execute and file an affidavit of appointment to accompany this resolution.
