RESOLUTION NO. 10-30-96-C

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Daniel King, a tribal member are holder of said lease no. RL-2210(90) more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land located within Claims 141 and 147, Section 3, T-23N., R 19E., more particularly described as: Commencing at the NE corner of said Claim 141 where it intersects with CTH "E"; thence N 60 degrees 51'W., a distance of 799.70 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence South 60 degrees 05'W., a distance of 40.32 feet; 95 feet; thence S 60 degrees 51'E., a distance of 105 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning, containing .23 acres, more or less, subject to all valid existing rights-of-way of record. (Lot 26)

WHEREAS, Daniel King, a tribal member holder of said lease no longer wishes to use said lease site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in Regular session assembled, hereby approve the above modification of lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease CANCELLATION documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
