RESOLUTION # 11-30-94-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has established the Oneida Social Services Department to promote the stability of Oneida Tribal members and their families; and has established an emergency/transitional shelter for Oneida Nation women and children in need; and

WHEREAS, The Streisand Foundation has changed its areas of interest for the 1994-95 funding docket to promote and support women's issues with a focus on the needs of children.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida tribe of Indians of Wisconsin make application to The Streisand Foundation for funding support of the Oneida Women and Children's Shelter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribal Chairwoman, or the Vice Chair, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.
