BC Resolution # 10-14-20-B Designated Representative to Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council, Inc. ("GLITC") is an organization made up of tribal nations that "supplements the member tribes' own efforts through development and operation of health and human service programs, education programs, and economic development programs in the reservation communities it serves. Intergovernmental relations and policy decisions find an intertribal discussion forum through GLITC;" and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a member of the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has determined that identifying a primary representative and alternates will assist in communications with GLITC and utilizing those resources;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Tehassi Hill, Chairman, is designated as the primary representative of the Nation on the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that Kirby Metoxen, Council Member is designated as the alternate of the primary representative of the Nation on the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council.

CERTIFICATION
