FY2021-2024 Oneida Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan (TTIP)

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** adequate transportation infrastructure is integral to service local and community needs; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee seeks to provide adequate transportation facilities to meet the needs of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee developed the 2021-2024 Oneida Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan, and it requests the Bureau of Indians Affairs incorporate it into the control schedule Transportation Improvement Plan as a required step to ensure the Oneida Nation receives its "Tribal Shares" funding; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee agrees with the needs and priorities presented in the 2021-2024 Oneida Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida Business Committee supports and adopts the FY2021-2024 Oneida Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan for the projects listed in the attached CSTIP forms that were developed between the Oneida Nation and the BIA for Tribal Shares funding along the corresponding 2021 TTP Retained services agreement (RSA).
